



When to Fly Your American Flag in 2025

The American flag should be displayed on all days and especially the holidays listed below. The dates marked in red color indicate when you should fly your flag at half staff. Sign up for our Flag Alerts to receive timely emails alerting you to flag events such as when to fly the flag at half staff.
